


 FLORIDA HIGHER EDUCATION LANDSCAPE




Frame of Reference

- We do not deny general admission to students without a valid high school diploma, but it might prevent the student from becoming degreeseeking at SPC, which will prevent the student from receiving federal financial assistance

Upon admission, students are required to take the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (P.E.R.T.), OPT-Accuplacer, or present scores on the ACT or SAT to determine appropriate course placement. Baccalaureate degree admission requirements depend on the program of study. Students seeking a Bachelor's degree at a college are encouraged to contact the college of interest.



Career and Technical Center Fast Facts

Over 320,000 students enrolled in a Florida public Career and Technical Center during the 2010-2011 year. More than 7,100 students participated in an Apprenticeship program at their chosen Career and Technical Center during the 2010-2011 year. 29 achool districts have one or more Career and Technical Center. The Bright Futures Gold Seal Vocational Scholars Award is available to hep eligible high school students pay futilion and fees at a Florida public Career and Technical Center.

Independent Colleges and Universities Independent Colleges and Universities In addition to public colleges and universities, Florida offers 29 private, not-for-profit, educational institutions all based in Florida and accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges & Schooks (SACS). These schools serve 135.000 students across Florida at 135 different locations. Florida's independent colleges and universities award nearly 22% of all the degrees earned in Florida each year. They vary in enrollment size from 200 to 29,000 students. Florida's independent colleges and universities guarantee access for all state college graduates as well. Nearly 80% of full- and part-time students do receive some form of financial aid. Admission requirements vary by school, so students must stay informed about what each program requires.





High School Diploma Scams

Sy Jane McDonaugh, errow Contributor

Millious of people each year inadvertently buy into "diplome mills," acams which huite unedwated folks to simply sign up and receive a degree online. These bogus institutions confer upon their student bodies folk degrees with little or no education or field experience supplied with them. As of 2010, about 400 diploma mills and 300 counterful degree institutions exist; it mak accreditation and legitimacy.



Belford High School

Also known as Refered University, this organization gives out counterfielt high <u>school</u> g diplomas and university degrees for thousands of dollars. They confer such degrees by letting students pass an examination based on "life experience" and do not offer education experience in any field of study. The transcripts from Belford are patently phony. In mix 2010, the Better Business Bureau (BBB) received 139 complaints in a space of three months.

Nation High School

Nation High is not a BBB <u>scoredited online school</u> of, and reserved an F grade on the BBB natings. Nation failed to respond to up to go compliants in a three-month period in 2010, as reported by the BBB. Based in Charlotts, NC (although its presents an unlinted and unknown address). Nation High School also goes by the name of "Global Education Service."

Jefferson High School/Vencer High School

School Sudaeta here pay more than \$200 for a high school diploma et, only to find that the diploma has no validity when enrolling in colleges. Sudaeta fill out a questionaire based on "fife experiences," and input information not relevant to their field of study, such as holdses and interest. Jefferson is owned by MMDS Lud, and based in St. Kitts a small country in the eastern Caribban. It also operates Vencer High School Onlines, which uses the exact same business model under a different name.

Belford Diploma Mill Lawsuit Awards Millions to Duped Students Diploma Mill Police > Fake Diploma News By Rachel Wang



A network of dpioma mills operating under the brand name of Belford suffered a financial blow after a federal court in Michigan mandated a 25.2 million payout to duped students who bought the group's fake GED dpiomas and college degrees. Belford High Shood and Belford University—both owned by Pakistani businesreme Stame Virsebi-Lot & faddrel cless action Beford University—both owned by Pakistani husinseman same Kuresh—lost a federal class-action http://www.getedu.cated.com/fake-diblomas. Now the POLICE Beford gorup of schools must make financial amends to Belford gorup of schools must make financial amends to their duped alumni in what authorities have ruled a degree mill scam involving several Internet domains, all operating under the Belford tagline.

On Aug. 31, 2012, U.S. District Judge Mark Goldsmith ordered Kureshi and his co-defendants to pay 522 7 million in a lawarul settlement to Betlord students in compensation for selling unaccretified dightomas and degrees. The Betlord scame neconosases 43 0500 paintiffs living in the U.S. who purchased a take dightan item Betlord High School or Betlord University from 2005 to 2009, at the stard of the lawarul.



Because diploma mills aren't accredited by a nationally recognized agency, you will not find the institution's accrediting agency on the U.S. Department of Education's List of Nationally Recognized Accrediting Agencies.

So what?

Effective July 1, 2011, all colleges and universities must:

"Develop and follow procedures to evaluate the validity of a student's high school completion if the institution or the Secretary has reason to believe that the high school diploma is not valid or was not obtained from an entity that provides secondary school education" (Higher Education Act \$ 668.16(p)).

Federal Regulations

Based on the GAO's recommendations, the U.S. Department of Education drafted a new rule defining a high school diploma. Under new Higher Education Act regulations (§ 668.16(p)), institutions are required to develop and follow procedures for evaluation of the validity of a student's high school completion if the institution or the Department of Education has reason to believe that the high school lopioma is not valid or was not obtained from an entity approved to provide secondary education. This regulation becomes effective July 1, 2011.

Compliance with this regulation involves collaboration between postsecondary institutions and the federal government:

- College and universities will develop procedures to follow in the case of a concerning credential.
 The U.S. Department of Education will maintain a list of public and private high schools and ask two questions on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) relevant to high school completion.

This collaborative effort will facilitate the review of suspect high school credentials.

Federal Role in Completion Verification

To help institutions identify diplomas that are suspect, the Department will establish and maintain a list of public and private high schools, populated by surveys from the Department's National Center for Education Statistics. Also, the department added two questions to the 2011-12 FAFSA (print and online) to assist institutions in identifying suspect high school completion. The following questions will be asked of first-year students: 26. When you begin college in the 2011-2012 school year, what will be your high school completion status?



In the online version, students will not be able to skip this question. Students who indicate they will have a high school diploma will be instructed to provide the name of the high school and the city and state where that school is located.



In the online version, students will not be able to skip this question and there will be a drop-down list of secondary schools maintained by the Department, as mentioned above. Students who cannot find their high school will be able to enter the information requested.

If replies to these questions do not correspond with the Department's list, the Department may select the student's FAFSA for further review by the institution to determine if the student has a valid high school diploma before the student can receive any Title VI federal student aid. In addition, if an institution has reason to suspect the validity of a high school diploma, regardless of FAFSA completion, the institution is responsible for determining validity.



- Determine if curriculum is consistent with a valid secondary education
- Determine if website is consistent with findings
- Other information/criteria as determined by the member institution if member institution has reason to believe the high school diploma is not valid.
- *"Diploma-test only" diplomas are considered invalid.

Validating High Schools

- The process is utilized by Florida public state colleges
- Each institution can "validate" a questionable high school and send its evaluation to the group



Challenges

- Keeping the list current as emails and forms are being prepared and submitted
- Not just the "official FCRAO list" but also each institution must keep a historical log for reference and audit purposes
- Process for "appeals" by schools not defined
- Update policy manual and admissions policies
- Impacts admission of dual-enrolled students as well

Recommendations

- Update your admissions and FA policies to acknowledge requirement of valid high school
- Update website if appropriate
- Decide what will be the criteria for determining validity and be able to defend that
- Keep a historical and chronological log for audits and reference
