

Amendment 8: Creating the Position of Treasurer-Elect

Purpose: The current Treasurer role is a very large role to undertake and unreasonable for one person. In keeping with the general trend of Associations nationwide, FASFAA is proposing the addition of a position of Treasurer-Elect. As envisioned, the elected candidate would serve one year as Treasurer-Elect and one year as Treasurer. In this way, there will always be a system of checks and balances between the current Treasurer and the Treasurer-Elect.

Original Text:

Article VI, Section 1 currently reads:

The officers of the Association shall be President, a President-Elect, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, a Past President, and such other officers as may be elected in accordance with the provisions of the bylaws.

Article VI, Section 2 does not current specify the position of Treasurer-Elect

Article VI, Section 5 does not currently specify roles for the position of Treasurer-Elect

Amended Text:

Article VI, Section 1 is proposed to be amended as follows:

The officers of the Association shall be President, a President-Elect, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, a Treasurer-Elect, an Immediate Past President, and such other officers as may be elected in accordance with the provisions of the bylaws. No person shall hold two offices simultaneously.

The following sentence is proposed to be added to the end of Article VI, Section 2:

The Treasurer-Elect shall serve one (1) year in that position and a second (2) year as Treasurer.

Article VI, Section 5 (which due to Amendment 9 below is renumbered to Section 4) is proposed to be amended by adding the following as Subpart E specifying duties of the Treasurer-Elect:

E. Treasurer-Elect

- assists the Treasurer in the completion of their duties
- works with the Treasurer to manage the transition of duties at the end of the fiscal year
- may be bonded at the expense of the Association
