Legislative Activity

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2018 Florida Legislative Updates

The 2018 Florida Legislative Session ended March 11, 2018.

CS/SB 4 Higher Education includes:

- Benacquisto Scholarship
 - Expands the Benacquisto Scholarship to include out-of-state National Merit Scholars.
 - Out-of-state students are exempt from paying out-of-state fees.

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship

- Florida Academic Scholars (FAS)
 - Changes the FAS award amount to cover 100 percent of tuition and specified fees at a public institution or comparable amount at a nonpublic institution.
 - Provides an additional \$300 for textbooks and college-related expenses (fall and spring).
 - Provides summer funding for FAS award recipients beginning in 2018.



2018 Legislative Updates, Continued

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship, Continued

- Florida Medallion Scholarship (FMS)
 - Changes the FMS award amount to cover 75 percent of tuition and specified fees at a public institution or comparable amount at a nonpublic institution.
 - Provides summer funding for FMS award recipients starting in 2019.



2018 Legislative Updates, Continued

- Florida Farmworker Student Scholarship Program
 - Creates the Florida Farmworker Student Scholarship Program to provide up to 50 scholarships for farmworkers and the children of farmworkers beginning with the 2018-19 academic year.
 - Provides an award equal to 100 percent of tuition and specified fees at a public postsecondary education institution in Florida.
- William L. Boyd, IV, Florida Resident Access Grant Program
 - Renames Florida Resident Access Grant Program to Effective Access to Student Education Grant Program.



2018 Legislative Updates, Continued

HB 5003 Implementing the 2018-19 General Appropriations Act

In addition to spring and summer Bright Futures Scholarship funding for students enrolled in the University of Florida's pilot program, the 2018-19 cohort of students will be eligible to receive the scholarship award for funding during the 2018 fall semester to be used for off-campus or online coursework.

Students must submit a completed Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) to OSFA for programs denoted by an asterisk (*). In order to apply for State Scholarship & Grant Programs, a student must first Create a Student Account. After logging into your account, you may proceed to complete the FFAA.



High Schools: Verify if your high school is a participating Florida public or private high school.

Postsecondary Institutions: Verify if the postsecondary institution you are planning to attend is eligible to disburse state aid.

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What You Need to Know State Calendar

Term 1 Disbursement – Reported on the DER 30 days after last day of drop/add

Term 1 Reconciliation – Refunds/ reconciliation due to OSFA within 60 days after last day drop/add

Bright Futures Refunds – Dropped/withdrawn (D04) funds are due within 30 days of last day of each term

Report 'Otherwise Eligible' Students (C99) – FSAG

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What You Need to Know Program Administration Reminder

Bright Futures Gold Seal CAPE (GSC)

Gold seal awards may only be used at postsecondary institutions that offer an applied technology diploma, technical degree education program (A.S. or A.A.S.), or a career certificate program.

Gold Seal CAPE Scholars who earn a qualifying A.S. or A.A.S. degree may receive \$48 per credit hour toward a qualifying B.S. or B.A.S. degree.



Program Administration Reminder

Bright Futures Gold Seal Vocational (GSV)

Gold Seal Vocational Scholars awards may only be used to fund:

- Applied Technology Diploma, up to 60 credit hours or equivalent clock hours
- Technical Degree Education Program, not to exceed
 72 hours or equivalent clock hours
- Career Certificate Program, not to exceed 72 credit hours or equivalent clock hours



Program Administration Reminder

Bright Futures – Restoration

- Students may only use summer coursework <u>to raise</u> <u>the GPA</u> for a one-time restoration at the end of the first year of funding only
- If the student did not earn the GPA after the first year of funding, restoration is not permitted
- If the student did not earn the hours, regardless of year of funding, restoration is not permitted



Program Administration Reminder

Bright Futures – Reinstatement

- Reinstatement is only for students who, although eligible, were not funded in the prior academic year
- Students who did not receive funding in the academic year immediately following high school graduation are required to apply for reinstatement of their award within 2 years of high school graduation
- Students must complete a Reinstatement/Restoration Application available on the OSFA website

September/ October	Term 1 Disbursement Eligibility Report (DER) is due to OSFA 30 days after the last day of drop/add.
October 1	The Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) is available to students for next academic year funding. OSFA begins collection of FAFSA/ISIR information from the United States Department of Education
November/ December	Term 1 reconciliations/refunds due to OSFA within 60 days after the last fay of drop/add.
December	Program funds sent to eligible PSIs for Term 2. Term 1 semester and quarter refunds of BF dropped/withdrawn course funds are due within 30 days of the institution's last day of each term.

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Disbursement Eligibility Report (DER) Continued

- OSFA encourages institutions to complete the DER prior to actually funding students to ensure students are allowed to be funded.
- Other checks made on the DER include:
 - Student owes for prior-year dropped/withdrawn hours
 - Student did not meet renewal requirements
 - Student has no remaining hours or terms
 - Student disbursement greater than allowable
 - Student previously awarded baccalaureate degree
 - Student is FMS and is <u>NOT</u> eligible for Summer funding



Term Refunds/Reconciliation

- Due within 60 days after the last day of drop/add.
- Reconciliation Report allows you to view your Disbursement Eligibility Report activity by year, term, program, and student.

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Bright Futures Drop/Withdrawal Funds

- Students are required to repay the Bright Futures portion of the cost of any courses dropped or withdrawn after the last day of drop/add
- Students repay the institution
- The institution is required to remit funds to OSFA within 30 days of the institution's last day of each term, regardless if the student has repaid the institution
